On February 11, 2021, George Washington University (GW) submitted a revised application to DC Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency (HSEMA) regarding the volleyball, soccer, and swimming and diving reopening plan for the 2021 season. DC Health reviewed your request and the revised application is APPROVED.

If you are notified of any positive COVID-19 cases from student-athletes, university staff, event employees, volunteers, or attendees, immediately inform DC Health of any COVID-19 laboratory-confirmed cases, following all procedures available at: <https://dchealth.dc.gov/page/covid-19-reporting-requirements>.

One further condition of this waiver is that you consent to allow inspectors from the Department of Health aka DC Health; the Alcohol and Beverage Regulation Administration (ABRA); and the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs (DCRA) to inspect facilities and practices to verify your compliance with this waiver and your plan, incorporated herein.

If there are changes to the operation plan from those authorized under this waiver, or request additional expansion for those activities disallowed at this time, you must come back to us to confirm that you are allowed to proceed with its new terms, and DC Health must also review any such modifications. Such assent is not automatic on our part and I will be your point of contact at chris.rodriguez@dc.gov.
