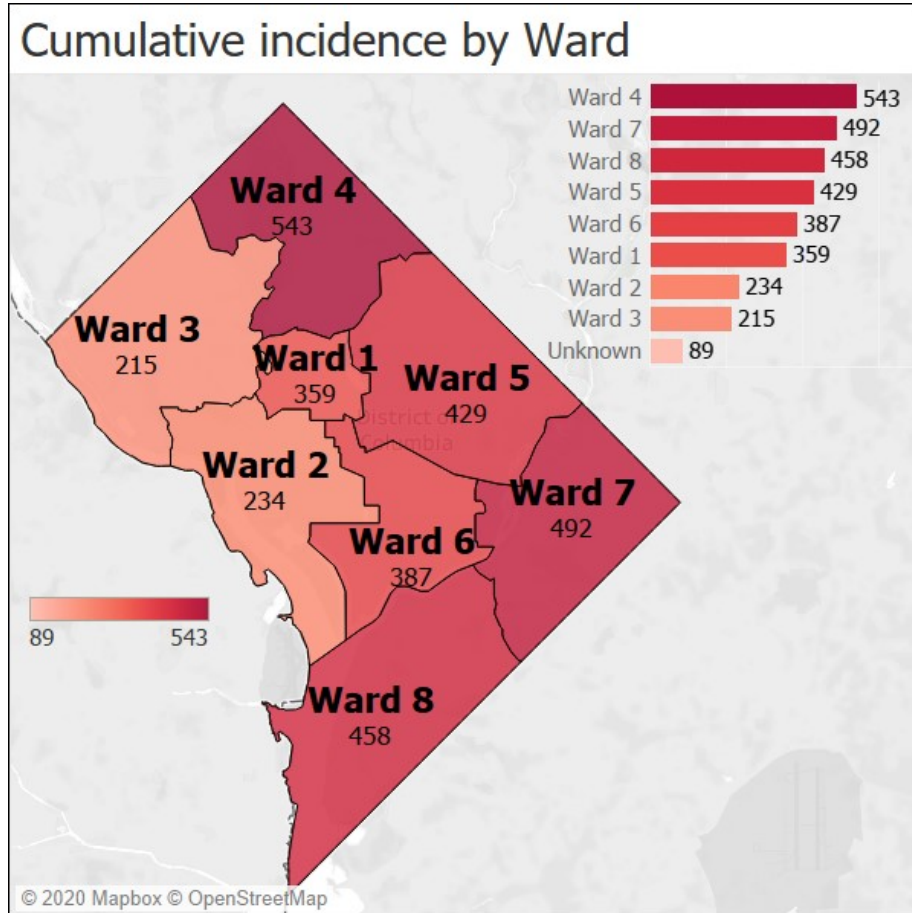

## REMINDERS

- Doctors decide who gets tested
- Testing asymptomatic people with exposure does not eliminate their need to self-quarantine if they have been instructed to do so

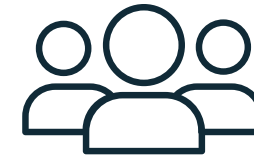

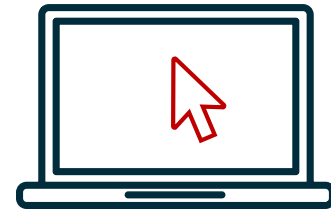
