


## **Heat Emergency**

Meal sites will remain open to all in need and a full list of locations and hours can be found on coronavirus.dc.gov/food



This Home Visit Team will conduct home visits and community outreach to individuals in the District who have tested positive for COVID-19 and their established contacts who have been placed in isolation or quarantine.

The team will assess an individual's need for additional social services, including alternative housing, food, and/or medication. Investigators will also assess a person's ability to safely quarantine or isolate, and, if necessary, connect residents to additional resources.
