On March 15, 2021, Georgetown University submitted an addendum to the DC Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency for the previously approved Georgetown University ReOpen DC Plan. The addendum requested restarting baseball, women's and men's golf, and women's and men's tennis; as well as, Georgetown hosting the Big East Championship for men's soccer, second and third rounds of NCAA Tournament for men's soccer, second and third rounds of NCAA Tournament for women's soccer, Big East Championship for women's lacrosse, preliminary rounds of NCAA Tournament for women's lacrosse, and preliminary rounds of NCAA Tournament for men's lacrosse. After incorporating DC Health requested changes to your addendum, the waiver is APPROVED.

If you are notified of any positive COVID-19 cases from student-athletes, university staff, event employees, volunteers, or attendees, immediately inform DC Health of any COVID-19 laboratory-confirmed cases, following all procedures available at: <https://dchealth.dc.gov/page/covid-19-reporting-requirements>.

One further condition of this waiver is that you consent to allow inspectors from DC Health to inspect facilities and practices to verify your compliance with this waiver and your plan, incorporated herein.

If there are changes to the operational plan from those authorized under this waiver, you must come back to us to confirm that you can proceed, and DC Health must review any modifications. Such assent is not automatic on our part and I will be your point of contact at chris.rodriguez@dc.gov.
