



Update on DC Public Charter School Board (PCSB) Operating Status during COVID-19 Emergency

NOTICE: The Public Health Emergency is now in effect through April 24; school and government reopen on April 27.

What is our operating status?

The DC Public Charter School Board (PCSB) remains operational and in service for the community. We are utilizing a full telework model and are able to provide continuous services.

How does this impact what we do?

- We will continue to operate our full functions remotely.
- We will hold our monthly board meetings virtually.
- We will communicate changes and updates with schools and the public via our website and social media platforms.
- We will respond as normal to community complaints received via email and phone.

How does this impact our physical locations?

- Our office located at 3333 14th Street NW, Suite 210 will be closed to the public starting Monday, March 16, 2020.
